***“Posting of Workers in the EU: Legislation and Practice”***

***10 March 2021***

***Virtual meeting***

The Revised Directive was to be transposed into national legislation by 31 July 2020. Many Member States have been late with the transpositions due to different reasons, however most Member States have transposed the Revised Directive in their national legislation by now. Seven months after the transposition due date it is worthwhile to examine how the Revised Directive works in practice and what is the companies' assessment of this directive.

The seminar will offer an opportunity to exchange on challenges companies face while posting workers across the EU. Such issues as access to information or administrative burdens related to the EU/national requirements will be discussed in depth. The discussions will be illustrated by concrete cases from companies as well as initiatives of the EU and national employers' organisations to support their members. The seminar will also aim at identifying good practices and working solutions, facilitating learning among employers' organisations and their member companies as well as defining concrete actions to remove barriers in posting.

### **Practical organisation**

We have approximately **25 places available** for BusinessEurope's member federations as well as their relevant affiliated sectoral and/or company representatives. SGI Europe (new name CEEP) and SMEUnited will also be invited to attend.

The meeting will be held in English, and no translation is foreseen.
